Shipmates and Ladies,

Our 2014 Woodrow Wilson Reunion is finally in sight. A great deal of effort has been put in over the past two years on the logistics and planning for a great reunion. This is a very special reunion as we will celebrate the 50th Anniversary of SSBN624. We're hoping for a large turnout. We have three special events planned, a Riverboat Tour, a Holiday Inn hosted Southwest Reception, and an all day trip to the Nimitz Museum in Fredericksburg, TX.

The entire hotel has recently completed a renovation which I reviewed in September. We will have our own Hospitality Room with adjacent restrooms. A full service restaurant and bar are located on the same floor. The hotel elevators will take you directly to the Riverwalk. You can walk the Riverwalk, or take a water taxi for \$15 per day unlimited PP. If you just want to cruise the river, the fee is \$8 PP for approximately one hour. The Alamo is within walking distance. We have blocked in 80 rooms including 3 handicapped rooms until **August 25, 2014**. The price of the hotel rooms is \$89 plus taxes.

The hotel has offered us a Full American Breakfast Buffet Daily which includes tax, tip, and beverage at a cost of \$10 PP per day.

PLEASE MAKE YOUR HOTEL RESERVATION ASAP, YOU CAN ALWAYS CANCEL WITHIN 24 HOURS OF OUR START DATE, SEPT. 22, 2014. KEEP IN MIND GROUP RATES ARE AVAILABLE THREE DAYS BEFORE AND AFTER THE ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE DATES, SEPT. 22nd - 26th BASED ON AVAILABILITY.
